Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

You are invited to **submit an application** for your **child/children in grades K-6**, to participate in the 21st Century Community Learning Center Afterschool Program at ANCCS.

What is the Afterschool Program: The ANCCS 21st CCLC is a federally grant funded, afterschool program designed to extend your child's educational experience beyond the regular school day. The grant has a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) focus. The Afterschool Program provides academic skills practice, enrichment activities, and recreational opportunities. The program's primary focus is to assist students who have academic and social needs. The Afterschool Program is **NOT** a day care program and there is no charge for students who are selected to attend.

Who may attend: Students currently attending ANCCS Elementary may apply. Enrollment is limited to 60 students in grades K-6 at this time. Student selection will be based on the following considerations:

- Teacher referrals
- Student level of achievement based on test scores and grades for the previous year
- Migrant Education eligibility status
- Child In Transition status
- English Language Learner status

When: Monday through Friday from 3:30-5:30pm (except holidays, Parent Teacher conference weeks and in-service days). The program will operate on the following two-semester schedule:

1st Semester: September 11-December 14, 2017
2nd Semester: January 16-April 19, 2018

To Apply for your Student

Complete an Application packet **for each child** in your family in grades K-6, who wishes to attend and return the forms to the 21st CCLC coordinator at ANCCS.

Dismissal

Student Pickup: The students will be available to go home at 5:25pm. Students **MUST BE PICKED UP BY 5:30**. Only the persons listed on your application form may pick up students. Anyone picking up students **must come into the school building and sign the child out** of the Afterschool Program. **ID cards will be requested** at sign out. Repeated failure to pick up students by 5:30 may result in students being dropped from the program. Students who regularly walk home will be dismissed at 5:30.

Attendance

Once a student has been accepted into the program and parents have received confirmation, it is expected that he/she will attend the program daily for both semesters. **The 21st CCLC office at 742-1370 option 1 must be notified by 3pm if a student will be absent on any day.** Three unexcused absences may cause your student to be removed from the Afterschool Program.

Acceptance Confirmation

All parents/guardians will be notified closer to the September 11th start date confirming or declining your child's acceptance into the program. **Parent/guardian attendance at our Orientation Meeting on September 8th is required.**
